 - a) Update NHERI Researchers Meeting. (Dan Cox and Julio Ramirez, 10')
Keynote speaker and panel participants on Day 1 are being contacted to firm up day one. The save the date announcement was released and preparation of the conference website, conference registration and hotel booking sites are in preparation. A survey to gather input from the community on possible sessions on Day 2 will be released before the Council's next meeting. Supplement work is underway.

 - i. User Forum Survey Update (Maggie Chamberlain and Mohammad Khosravi, UF Chair) (15')
User Survey team began collecting information on July 1, 2021 using the module developed for distribution with research exit surveys at facilities. Already this survey has exceeded the number of responses of previous surveys. In addition, a survey will be distributed to all NHERI users via DesignSafe-CI.
 - ii. Facility Dashboard –update (Dan Zehner)
Thank you to all the facilities for their cooperation to keep it up to date.
 - c) Facility status updates (All)
NCO: submitted final report for previous award and received NSF approval.
DesignSafe-CI: continues efforts to promote data re-use.
UC Davis: additional staff has been added. Ross reported the first accident at the facility.
SimCenter: reported that Barb Simpson from OSU is participating on the visiting researcher program. Announced the Nov. 4 bi-annual symposium, and its participation in activities with the NHERI Graduate Council.
CONVERGE: its activities to gain access to burn sites are ongoing with limited success.
RAPID: reported on activities related to the RAPID Scholars Program. In this program, where students write proposals to use RAPID instruments, has received already more than 40 applications. Joe offered to share winning proposals with the Council.
University of Florida: booked through June of 2023.
Oregon State University: will be very busy with testing this summer, and will host 3 REUs
Lehigh University: completed Phase 1 of hybrid simulation with FIU, will be hosting 4 REUs this summer including two from Puerto Rico, and hosting an early career researcher workshop.
Florida International University: NICHE planning work is ongoing, and three new projects coming.
